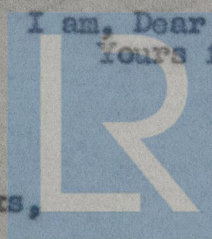
I have to add that, as the generator is used for charging a battery, no exception will be taken in this instance to the use of a shunt wound machine.
