Electrical Equipment.

The Builders state the generator has been manufactured and is shunt wound for battery charging. Section 2, Clause 2, of the Rules for Electrical Equipment requires generators to be compound wound.

As the generator is used for charging a battery, it is considered that as in previous cases the use of a shunt wound machine merits approval.

IT IS SUBMITTED that provided the installation be as shown and amended on the plans *of heater in Deck Saloon & there's space* and to the Surveyors' satisfaction and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electrical Equipment be complied with, the plans merit approval.

It should be pointed out that as the generator is used for charging a battery no exception will be taken in this instance to the use of a shunt wound machine.

It is noted that the Owner has decided to fit a closed panel pattern heater in the boudoir in lieu of the open type originally proposed.
