I duly received your letter of the 12th instant respecting the electrical installation proposed for the above vessel, and have to acquaint you that the plans of electrical equipment will be approved, provided the installation be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of the Rules for Electrical Equipment be complied with.

In regard to the heaters I have to point out that these are to comply with Section 10, Clause 6 of the Rules. In this respect, the use of a radiant type heater in the Boudoir cannot be approved, and, in order that full consideration may be given to the use of a radiant heater in the deck saloon, detailed plans of the position should be submitted for consideration. As regards the crew space panel heaters, details of the fixing on board should be submitted.

One set of the plans is returned herewith, the catalogues being retained in this Office for reference purposes.
