

Yacht No. 847.

We have received to-day a letter from your local Surveyor regarding the couplings for shafting of above Yacht and now have to reply to you direct, as arranged with your Surveyor.

The slight alteration that we made after the drawing was approved by you was at the request of Mr. Norman Hart, the Naval Architect, so as to make all couplings the same as approved by you for the main engine crank coupling.

It was a small alteration in no way detracting from the strength of coupling that you had already accepted from the Engine Builder, at the same time we should have referred this matter to you - an omission for which please accept our apologies.

We now enclose you three tracings shewing the couplings as follows:-

- A. Shafting coupling as approved.
- B. " " as made.
- C. Crankshaft coupling approved by you for Engines.

If you will superimpose these tracings you will see the couplings B as made are slightly stronger in the neck than required by the approved drawing A and considerably stronger than crankshaft coupling C.

Seeing these couplings are now all machined and fitted and that this slight alteration has in no way impaired the strength,

we think your Surveyor is rather inclined to make trouble unnecessarily, if we had weakened the couplings the attitude he has taken would have certainly been correct.
