E. I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo, enclosing a copy of one received by your goodself from Messrs. Philip & Son Ltd. respecting the above yacht.

I note the Builders state it is impossible for water to syphon back through the W.C. fittings and, in the circumstances, I have to inform you that the plan showing the arrangement of discharges from W.Cs. and scuppers from deck will be approved, provided the full bore and sluice shut-off valves at the ship's side are fitted in positions that will be always readily accessible.

I have further to inform you that similar arrangements will be accepted for the galley sinks, provided these sinks be fitted as high above the load water line as practicable.

One copy of the plan is returned herewith.
