I am in receipt of your letter of the 29th instant with enclosures as advised regarding the cast steel stem and stern pieces manufactured by Messrs. Haine St. Pierre Forges-Usines & Ponderies, S.A. Haine Saint Pierre, Belgium for your Yard No. 847, and in reply I beg to state that, as pointed out in my letter of the 21st December 1937, the Society's fee for the special superintendence of the vessel during construction does not include the fees for testing steel plates, forgings, castings, chain cable, etc. These fees are charged by the Society direct to the Manufacturers and are paid by the latter unless some special arrangement has been agreed upon between the Shipbuilders and the Manufacturers when the contract for the vessel was placed.

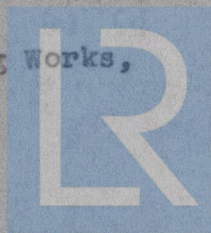
