I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th instant respecting the stem casting for your Yard No. 847 from which it is noted that some difficulty has been experienced in obtaining this casting in one length, and it is therefore proposed to arrange a butt at about the middle of the length, the joint to be electrically welded on the outside and a double riveted strap, $\frac{5}{8}$ inches in thickness, fitted on the inside.

With regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that this proposed arrangement will be approved, provided the rivets in the strap be made $\frac{7}{8}$ inch diameter.

The plan forwarded with your letter is returned herewith.
