



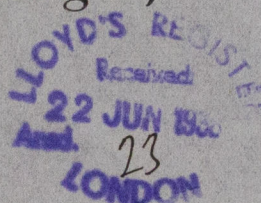

Pumping arrangement is fitted and starting air-vessels have been tested by hydraulic pressure as required.
