Letters have been received from the Society's Surveyor at Groningen (dated the 18th instant) and also from the Owner (22nd instant) respecting the two Humboldt-Deutz engines of 115 H.P. each at 750 r.p.m. intended for the propulsion of the above yacht.

The Owner is very anxious that these engines should comply with the Society's Rules for full classification and requests that the matter may be taken up with the Dusseldorf Surveyors, as he understands that delivery will be delayed should the engines have to be constructed under the Society's Survey.

IT IS SUBMITTED that copies of both the letters referred to be forwarded to the Dusseldorf Surveyors with a request that they should take up the matter of classification of these engines with the Builders.

The Dusseldorf Surveyors might also be informed that engines from stock could be accepted for full classification, provided the main forgings used be constructed under the Society's Survey and the usual pressure tests be applied to water jackets, etc.

As the Owner is anxious to know at an early date what his position is, the Surveyors should be requested to give this matter their early attention and advise this Office of the position.
