Dear Sirs,

M. I return, under separate cover, one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Lodder's letter of the 24th ultimo, of midship section, profile & decks and bulkheads of a steel twin screw motor yacht No. 217 proposed to be built by Messrs. Scheepswerf Gebr. Niestern & Co., of Delfzyl, and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A- in the Yacht Register.

The steel to be used in the construction of this vessel must be made by the Open Hearth process at works recognised by the Committee, and must be tested in accordance with requirements of the Rules.

If the figure "1" is desired particulars of the equipment proposed to be supplied should be submitted for consideration.

The duplicate copy of each of the plans is being retained for reference.
