I have to acquaint you that the steamer "IROQUOIS" recently arrived in London, and the Society's Surveyors have been informed that she is proceeding to Belfast where tentative arrangements are being made for the 2nd Special Survey No.3 to be held.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will give the case attention.

I may say that a plate in the centre strake of trunk top requires to be renewed at this Special Survey, and welded plates in C and G strakes starboard side to be examined at the next drydocking. You will observe that the survey of the starboard screwshaft became due last April.
