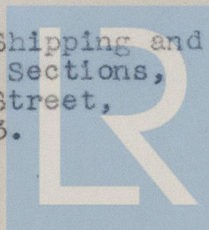
I think it well to point out that a further General Examination of the hull is required before the end of the present month, and it is concluded that this inspection will take place when the engines are submitted for examination.
