I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have today had before them a report received from the Society's London Surveyors of survey held last month on the Dutch motorship "RIAN". The Surveyors state that the requirements of survey for the assignment of special record of "Examined L.R. 7,40" have been complied with so far as the hull is concerned, but that through an oversight no opportunity was afforded for the engines to be examined under working conditions. It is understood that opportunity will be given for this omission to be rectified in the near future, and in these circumstances the Committee have deferred the assignment of the special record pending such an inspection.
