SOURCE OF INFORMATION.

Action regarding the carrying out of the 2nd Special Survey No. 3 (due 5.40) etc., was deferred as the vessel was under requisition to the Admiralty.

The vessel later became the property of the Ministry of Transport but Messrs. Jas. N. Connell have now informed the Society's Glasgow Surveyors that they have purchased the vessel for breaking up. The vessel is at present lying at Fort William but will be brought round to the Clyde for breaking up when the weather improves. The Glasgow Surveyors will advise this Office later when the work of demolition has been commenced.
