


TUG "SECURITY"

We have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 17th October relative to the above named tug and beg to inform you that we are making every effort to arrange a berth suitable for withdrawing the Screwshaft in order to carry out the requisite inspection. We have so far been unsuccessful but have arranged to occupy the appropriate berth of the Clifton Slipways Co, Gravesend, (which is at present occupied) as soon as it is vacated, which we are informed should be in about a fortnight's time, and will keep you advised accordingly.

Regarding the Boiler Survey. We have to inform you that tubes have been delivered and we are waiting the Repairers advices in order to carry out complete retubing and will notify you as soon as a definite date can be given.

May we suggest that it would be suitable to carry out the Load Line Survey at the same time.
