As you are aware we are acting for Mrs. Pattison and Mrs. Connelly in this matter and we would now refer to our telephone conversation with Mr. Cook (speaking to Mr. Walker) when we discussed the availability of Mr. Young and Mr. Widgery as witnesses for the Plaintiffs.

We understood from Mr. Cook that Mr. Young is now in Japan, but that Mr. Cook could arrange for a suitable Officer of the Register to produce certain documents upon subpoena duces tecum on Mr. Young's behalf. We also understood that Mr. Widgery is now in London and available for subpoena duces tecum personally.




For your information, these matters have been set down for hearing during the Easter Law sitting which commences on April 22nd, so that an early reply to this letter would be most appreciated.
