With reference to your letter of the 11th ultimo, respecting the Steam Trawlers "ANDANES", "IMELDA", "E & F" (now named "LAVEROCK") and "LADY ELEANOR", I have to acquaint you I have been in communication with Messrs. J. Marr & Son Ltd., of Fleetwood, and I am in receipt of a letter from them reading as follows:-

"We duly received your letter of the 14th instant, enclosing copy of a letter received from your London Office respecting the Steam Trawlers "ANDANES", "IMELDA", "LAVEROCK" (ex "E & F") and "LADY ELEANOR". We confirm our re-purchase of these four vessels from the Ministry of Transport, but would also inform you that in each case they have been resold for the express purpose of scrapping, and that in the circumstances, the question of surveys for class maintenance will not arise."
