I duly received your letter of the 11th instant, respecting the steamer "GARTH," and have to acquaint you that this case has received the careful consideration of the Committee.

In all the circumstances, the Committee regret that, consistently with the course followed in similar instances, they have no alternative but to expunge this vessel's class and to give instructions for a record of "wrecked 11.46" to be made against the vessel's name in the Society's Register Book.

I may add, however, that in the event of the vessel being repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately upon reclassification by this Society.
