The CARDIFF Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated, a GENERAL EXAMINATION held, and repairs effected to keel, shell and deck plates, etc.

Repairs as above now effected to stem and stem plating, keel and bottom plating (p.s.f).

Deep tank top plating as above examined and found somewhat thin, but considered efficient meantime. The Surveyor recommends all covering being removed and plating dealt with as found necessary at the next S.S.

On account of striking quay wall etc. repairs effected to shell plating, bulkheads, and minor items.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as classed, with record of docking survey 11.46, subject to covering of deep tank top being removed and plating dealt with as found necessary at the next S.S. and to 15 fathoms of chain cable being renewed or repaired and tested at the first opportunity, but without other condition; and to have the notation "Examined 11.46", valid for 12 months, assigned as recommended.
