I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo enclosing a plan in connexion with a proposal to convert the hold of the S.S. "NORTHGATE" into a sand carrying compartment by fitting sloping bulkheads at the ends and sides of the existing hatchway, and your remarks have been duly noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that in the circumstances a sketch has been prepared in this Office shewing the scantlings and arrangements which could be approved for the new bulkheads, and a copy is enclosed for your information.

On completion of the alterations to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors, the notation "Fitted for pumping and carrying sand in bulk" will be added to the class of the vessel.
