("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The Cardiff Surveyors report this vessel afloat, the sloping ^{partial} transverse bulkheads at ends of sand compartment recently fitted at Blyth, cropped and refitted vertically and alterations to hatchway etc. carried out as per approved plan and the ceiling in bottom of sand compartment renewed.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, but to have notation of "Fitted for pumping and carrying sand in bulk".
