Referring to your letter of the 7th ultimo, relative to the above mentioned case, I may say that the usual particulars of Freeboard and a copy of the certificate were forwarded with our official letter of the 23rd ultimo.

Mr. Hudson states that the pumping arrangements are in accordance with the Rules and that the electrical equipment was overhauled and the electrical Rules for vessels carrying petroleum in bulk have been complied with.

He also states that he requires the approved plans of the boilers and of the pumping arrangements in connection with a similar conversion. I am accordingly arranging to obtain copies from Mr. George Drake, the Owners' Consultant, when he returns to the city.

The heating surface for the starboard boiler is reported to be 7168 square feet and for the port boiler 2912 square feet.

I attach the test sheet for the new intermediate shaft installed.
