"BULK OIL" or "DANIEL WEBSTER".

This vessel was originally built as a cargo steamer and was classed 100A1 Shelter deck with freeboard.

The vessel has now been converted into a tanker and the New York Committee have assigned the class 100A1 Carrying petroleum in bulk etc.,

Freeboard therefore is not a condition of class, but it would appear that a tanker freeboard of 7'-0" has been assigned.

It is submitted the New York Office be requested to state if Convention tanker freeboards have been assigned by them to this vessel and if so they should forward the usual particulars and copy of certificate in order that the necessary records may be made in the Register Book.
