I am in receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the fees charged for the survey for reclassification and conversion into a tanker of the steamer "BULKOIL", and have to thank you for the information furnished.

The fee of \$200 for approval of plans, \$50 of the freeboard assignment fee, and \$114 expenses have, I note, been passed through the New York Rough Fee Book as due to the New York account; and these sums have, in consequence, been credited to the New York account in the books in this Office. In order to give effect to what appears to be the intended distribution, it has been thought best to credit the remaining fees to the Newport News account, with a special note to the effect that, with one exception, the Surveyor is to credit 50% thereof to the Society. The one exception is the \$50 in respect of the freeboard fee, which it would seem in this instance is to be credited to Mr. Hudson net.
