Dear Sir,

I have to-day received Newport News Report No. 5002 on the survey for re-classification and conversion into a tanker of the steamer "BULKOIL".

The fees as stated on the report are:-


Conversion to tanker, approving plans and new freeboard	£1800
S.S. 2nd No. 3	£ 630
Special Survey - machinery	£ 200
T.S., E. Light and boiler	£ 105

It is thought that some part of these fees is probably due to the New York account, and I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to let me know whether this is so, and in that event, the amount so due.

Moreover, it is desirable that, if possible, the entries in the books here should be so analysed as to show the freeboard fee separately from the other fees making up the total of \$1800, and the electric light fee from the others comprising the sum of \$105.

In order there shall be no delay in posting the records of classification in the Register Book by

reason of our having no knowledge of the payment of these fees, I shall be glad if you will be so good as to arrange for immediate advice of payment to be sent to me.

I think it well to remind you that the new edition of the Register Book is now in course of preparation. The section containing particulars of the steamer "BULKOIL" is due for press on the 11th May, and if records of the vessel's classification are to appear in the new Book, it is essential that advice of payment be received in London before the date named.
