Dear Sir:-

I duly received your letter of the 29th inst. submitting for consideration Plan No. 18-16, showing Swash Bulkheads in the case of the above vessel, from which it is noted that the top strake of same has been increased from .34 to 1/2", to take the place of the deck doubler recommended by our London Office, in order to allow the vessel a tanker freeboard.

With regard thereto I have to state that, as this arrangement was made with Dr. Montgomerie upon his visit here, the same will be approved, and the vessel assigned a freeboard under the Tanker Rules.

The plan has been signed and is returned herewith.
