

Steel Twin Screw Motor Yacht "CAROLITA" ex "RIPPLE"

Rule Dimensions : 126' x 23' x 13.15'

Scantling numbers : 24.65 and 3106

Proportions : Length = 9.58 depths.

This vessel was built in 1923 by Messrs. Fried Krupp Germaniawerft to the design of Mr. Daniel Cox, of Messrs. Cox & Stevens, of New York. She was not built under the survey of any Classification Society, but was inspected by the Society's Surveyors at Hamburg for the purpose of issuing a certificate to the effect that the "yacht has been completed in accordance with the terms of the contract for its construction".

The yacht has recently been under survey at New York with a view to classification with this Society, and in forwarding the First Entry Report the Surveyors ask if the "X" could be added to the 100A1 class.

The records in this Office have been examined and it is found that the materials used in the construction were not tested by the Society's Surveyors, and that the vessel was framed and half plated, with the bulkheads fitted, before the Surveyors paid their first visit. In these circumstances it is considered that the "X" signifying that the vessel has been built under the Society's supervision should not be assigned, and it is submitted the New York Surveyors be informed accordingly.
