Referring to your letter of May 23rd, we hereby approve, subject to confirmation by the Equitable Trust Co., the arrangement made between our Mr. Irving Cox and your Mr. Erbach, as follows:-

Relating to the provisions of the contract dated Dec. 19, 1922, between yourselves and Mr. Clifford M. Leonard for the construction of a Diesel yacht, Paragraph 16, as relates to arbitration, - the provisions of the paragraph in this contract are that the local representative of Lloyd's Register of Shipping at Kiel shall be the umpire of the Board of Arbitrators appointed to settle any disputes that may arise. In view of the fact that there is not a regular representative of Lloyd's Register of Shipping at Kiel, it has been agreed between our Mr. Irving Cox and your Mr. Erbach that a representative of Lloyd's Register at Copenhagen shall act as the umpire of any Board of Arbitrators appointed under this contract.
