Dear Mr. Scott:-

I duly received your letter of the 26th April, enclosing copies of letters passed between you and Mr. Geo. Dykes in connection with the fees for the survey of the Motor Yacht being constructed by Messrs. Fried Krupp A.G. Germaniawerft, Kiel, Germany, to the design of Messrs. Cox and Stevens.

I understand from Mr. Daniel Cox that his brother Irving had an interview with you regarding the fees for the survey of the above mentioned yacht, and also for the Yacht "Oceanus" S.472 building by the same firm to the design of Cox and Stevens for Mr. John W. Kiser, and that the fee chargeable in each case would be \$500.00.

With reference to the last paragraph of your letter, I have been unable to find out from either Cox and Stevens or W. Gardiner, the name of the American owner for whom a yacht is being built by Messrs. Frerichs Einswarden. If Mr. Dykes could get the name of the Owner or designer, I shall endeavour to get in with either of them.
