re Yacht building at Kiel for Messrs Cox & Stevens  
New York

In reply to your letter of the 18th instant the contents of which have been carefully noted it is to be remarks as regards the instructions in connection with the Survey of this yacht that it is in keeping with the original letter received from Mr Scott

From the enclosed letter which Mr Cox sent to this Office it would appear that there is a difference of opinion both as regards the Fees to be paid and for the services desired to be rendered, and with regard thereto you will no doubt agree that it is desirable that a clear understanding should be arrived at as to the Fees to be paid and the nature and extent of the services to be rendered for according to the enclosed letter Mr Cox has written it would appear that he considers a fee of about one half that stated in Mr Scott's letter should meet the case and secondly that only a survey of the yacht was desired on her completion,

The remarks embodied in Mr Cox's letter coincides with the verbal statement he made to Mr Cairns and myself and further confirmed by him a few days later to Mr Priess and Mr Witt at Kiel

We are all extremely anxious and desirous not only to satisfy Mr Cox but to fulfill the Committees intentions and to avoid any question being raised later on.
