Dear Mr Scott,

Referring to your letters of the 20th and 26th ultimo respecting the Motor yacht building by Messrs, Fried. Krupp A.G. Germania Werft, Kiel for Mr Daniel H. Cox of Messrs Cox & Stevens, New York, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that Mr Priess & Witt met Mr Cox at Krupp's yard yesterday who informed them, that it would only be necessary for the Surveyors to visit this yacht (and a sister yacht about to be built for which we had no official order so far) and to certify that the requirements of the specifications had been fulfilled and that he thought that for such services a fee of £50 per yacht would meet the case and that I was to write to him to his address in Kiel the amount of Fees the Society proposed charging for the yacht for which you forwarded plans and Specifications.

It would appear that one could not certify to the fact that the requirements of the specifications had been fulfilled unless this was controlled during the construction of the hull and motors

I enclose you the copy of a letter which I have today sent to Mr Cox, for your information, and instructions

Should he reply I shall forward you his letter and await your decisions,

It is understood that the 3rd yacht previously referred to will be built to the Society's Class,
