Dear Sir,

Our colleagues Mr. Priess and Mr. Witt who had the pleasure of meeting you yesterday at Kiel inform us, that

- 1st You consider it only desirable on completion of the Yacht at present building by Messrs. Fried. Krupp A.G. Germania-werft, Kiel, that one or two visits should be made by the Surveyors and a statement issued in the form of a letter certifying, that the requirements of the specification had been fulfilled,
- 2nd You desire to be informed the amount of Fees chargeable in connection with this Survey.

In reply to the question raised

- 1st It is not quite clear from the statements as to whether you desire on completion of the yacht for the Surveyors to certify, that the requirements of the specification have been fulfilled in detail as we understood from the Secretary or that it is only desired by your goodself, that a general statement be made, certifying to completion of the yacht as far as seen,
- 2nd with regard to the Fees to be charged it was understood from the Secretary that this had been arranged between the London and New York Offices of the Society and your goodself.

On hearing further from you on this matter we shall submit the matter to the Secretary in London for further instructions.
