Dear Mr. Scott:-

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th ult., regarding the motor yacht being constructed by Messrs. Fried, Krupp, Aktiengesellschaft Germaniawerft, Kiel, Germany, to the design of Messrs. Cox and Stevens, in respect of which it is desired by Mr. Cox that a certificate should be issued by the Society's Surveyors on completion. I have again interviewed Mr. Cox on the subject and have obtained from him the desired formal request upon Request Form 8a, which document is enclosed herewith.

In connection with the escrow agreement it appears to be considered extremely important that the certificate should be issued from this office immediately upon a satisfactory report being cabled from Europe, and the agreement is understood to have been especially drafted with this end in view.

Mr. Cox has been informed of your suggestion that the report, signed by the Surveyor who actually inspects the yacht, should be mailed, but he is unwilling to agree to the delay which would be occasioned thereby and, in these circumstances, I trust that you would approve of the suggestion as originally made, the certificate issued from this office being prepared on Report Form 10.

It is recognized that the survey required is of considerable extent, and the fees mentioned by you will be agreed to.
