We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to inspect upon completion the Motor Yacht being constructed to our designs by Messrs. Fried, Krupp, Aktiengesellschaft Bermaniawerft, for Clifford M. Leonard of Chicago, and if considered by them to be satisfactory to issue a certificate that the Yacht has been completed in accordance with the terms of the contract for it's construction and delivery to the Purchaser at Kiel, Germany. We should be obliged if this certificate might be issued from the New York office of Lloyd's Register upon cabled advices from the Surveyor engaged upon the inspection.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—

While the Committee use their best endeavours to ensure that the functions of the Society are properly executed, it is to be understood that neither the Committee nor the Society are under any circumstances whatever to be held responsible for any inaccuracy in any report or certificate issued by the Society or its Surveyors, or in any entry in the Register Book or other publication of the Society, or for any error of judgment, default, or negligence of the Surveyors, or other Officers or Agents of the Society.
