Dear Mr. French,

Reverting to my letter of the 20th instant, regarding the case of the motor yacht which is being constructed by Messrs. Fried Krupp A&G. Germania Werft, Kiel, Germany, to the design of Messrs. Cox & Stevens, I think it well to enclose for your information a copy of a letter, dated the 23rd instant, which I have received from Mr. George Dykes, the Principal Surveyor for Germany, upon the subject, together with a copy of my reply.
