Mr. Daniel H. Cox, of Cox and Stevens, inquired recently in connection with a motor yacht which is being constructed to their designs by Messrs. Fried, Krupp Aktiengesellschaft Germaniawerft, at Kiel, Germany, as to whether it would be possible for this to be inspected by the Society's Surveyors on completion and a certificate furnished in accordance with an Escrow Agreement made between the Owners and the Builders.

I informed Mr. Cox I had no doubt that this arrangement would be authorized by the Committee, and I am now enclosing a letter received from Cox and Stevens, together with the enclosures referred to as follows, namely:-

Building Contract.
Escrow Agreement.
Specifications
Contract Plans.

u It will be noted that the Owners desire these papers to be treated as absolutely confidential. *u*

The certificate which is desired is contained in paragraph 7, Page 4 of the Escrow Agreement, and I should be glad if you would issue the necessary instructions to the Society's Hamburg Surveyors, providing, of course, that the arrangement is approved of by yourself. The examination required appears to be extensive, and it seems to me that a fee at least equivalent to the ordinary classification survey fee, or possibly rather more, should be charged.

The certificate, it will be observed, is desired to be issued from the New York office, and probably you would arrange for a cable to be sent to myself by the Surveyors upon the satisfactory conclusion of their inspection.
