Messrs. Raevall & Co. Ltd., Surveyor to this Society did at their works at the request of the 8th & 11th March 1926, for the purpose of witnessing the hydraulic testing of one vertical two stage type compressor, designated No. 18806, constructed to the order of Messrs. Alex. Stephen & Son, Ltd., Linthouse, Govan.

The several parts have been hydraulic tested as follows, the results satisfactory.

H.P. CYLINDER.	750 lbs per sq.inch.
L.P. CYLINDER	100 lbs per sq.inch.
JACKETS.	150 lbs per sq.inch.

On completion of erection the Compressor it was coupled to a 5 B.H.P. Motor made by Messrs. J.H. Holmes & Co. Ltd., and run full load for a duration of 8 hours and found satisfactory.

The Compressor was afterwards opened up, working parts examined and found satisfactory, for identification the Compressor is stamped *A.E.F.*

A copy of the results of the test is attached hereto.


