E. With reference to the correspondence which passed between us in November/December last respecting the Composite Auxiliary Schooner Yacht "CHIMERE", I send herewith, for your information, a copy of a letter which has to-day been addressed to Messrs. Bruntons (Sudbury 1919) Ltd. in regard to a Chain Reduction Gear and Case which they are to supply for a 6L3 Gardner Engine intended for this vessel.

It will be observed that it is proposed to retain the existing screw shaft, and I have to inform you that with engines having particulars as stated in my communication to Messrs. Bruntons', and a propeller 48" diameter, the minimum size of screw shaft required by the Rules for a bronze shaft or a shaft without a continuous liner is 3.25" diameter.
