Dear Sirs,

Y. I have to enclose Nantes Reports Nos. 1267 and 1272 on the yacht "ELENI" ex "LESMONA V" together with a copy of a letter which was addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Nantes on the 2nd March 1922 in the case, and copies of letters from them dated the 7th March and the 11th May, and with regard thereto, to acquaint you that a letter has now been received from the owner, Mr. D. Nicolaides, in which he states that he expects to put the vessel into dry dock at your Port in a month or two, where the survey for classification is to be completed, and I have to request that you will give the case the necessary attention.

I have also to state that for this purpose certain requirements of paragraph 2, Section 109 of the Society's Rules, require to be carried out. The enclosed reports should be returned by you after notation.

With regard to the auxiliary machinery of the vessel I have to state that no report or particulars have been received, nor is it known whether the owner desires the motor to be classed, but I am communicating with him on the subject.

I have to add that the owner has been informed that the amount of the fee cannot be definitely fixed until the survey is completed, but that a fee of at least £20 will be charged for the survey of the hull and machinery.
