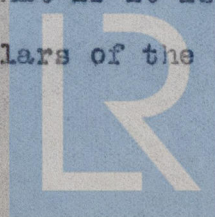

I duly received your telegram respecting the yacht "ELENI" ex "LESMONA V", and with regard thereto I have to state that in order that the vessel may be classed in the Society's Register of Yachts it will be necessary for full particulars of the scantlings to be ascertained for the Committee's consideration. If it is possible for plans of the vessel to be obtained showing the original scantlings these could be examined with a view to seeing whether the vessel could be recommended to the Committee for classification, but if this is not possible the only course would be for the scantlings to be measured from the yacht, drillings being taken of the shell plating for this purpose.

The survey which would require to be held is the Special Survey No.3, and the survey would require to be in accordance with Section 109 of the Rules for Yachts.

I have also to state that if it is also desired to class the motor full particulars of the same should be submitted for consideration.
