Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register of Yachts of your Screw Schooner Yacht "MARION", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had this case under consideration in view of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the 4th Special Survey No.1 will expire at the end of the present month. It would appear from a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Southampton that the vessel is still laid up in Poole Harbour, and I would explain that in such cases it is the Committee's usual practice to require Owners to furnish an undertaking stating that all overdue surveys will be carried out before the vessel is again placed in service.

The Committee conclude you will have no objection to doing so in this instance and I enclose a printed form of undertaking which I shall be obliged if you will kindly sign and return to this Office in due course. A duplicate copy of the form is also enclosed for your filing purposes.
