I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 19th instant, from which it is noted that the Screw Schooner Yacht "MARION" is still laid up in Poole Harbour.

In addition to the Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys which are now very much overdue and which are required to be held before the yacht again proceeds to sea, the 4th Special Survey No.1 became due at the end of July last.

The case was submitted to the Committee at their meeting today and, in the circumstances, action has been deferred for the present whilst the vessel is laid up.
