With reference to my letter of the 2nd ultimo respecting the classification in the Society's Register of Yachts of your Screw Schooner Yacht "MARION", I beg to acquaint you that I have received a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Southampton stating that they have been informed that the yacht is preparing for a voyage to the Mediterranean.

I would, however, remind you of the conditions under which the yacht has been allowed to retain her class in the Society's Register of Yachts whilst she was laid up, viz:- that the Boiler Survey which became due so long ago as July 1933 be carried out in its entirety and the screw shaft drawn for examination before the vessel proceeds to sea.

I shall therefore be glad if you will be good enough to let me hear further from you in the matter at your earliest convenience.
