In reply to enquiry regarding the above surveys the Owner writes as follows:-

"I wrote you on receipt of your previous communication, stating that the 'MARION' had not been in commission for two years, and up to date has been lying at her moorings. Under these circumstances I presume it is absolutely unnecessary to have any survey made, and seeing that the boat has not been used for some years, I should like to know whether it is necessary to remove the screwshaft for examination."

Submitted the owner he informed that the screwshaft need not be drawn for examination until the vessel goes into commission.
