


On the 3rd October, 1927, Mr. W. Lyon visited Messrs. Braby's Deptford Works to examine and test five tanks intended for the yacht "LILY MAID IV".

On three of these tanks it was noted that a pad described as a level gauge seating was missing. These pads were subsequently fitted, the tanks re-galvanised, and a further visit was necessary to re-examine and test these tanks.

On the 11th October, 1927, Mr. Murray visited the works and carried out this further examination and test.

The time taken on each occasion was about three hours, and the fee charged was £3.3.0.
