Précis of particulars of Casualty

This yacht was found sunk in Genoa harbour when that port was captured in April, 1945. Her condition was not too bad and it is considered to be an easy matter to raise her.

In reply to enquiry, the Genoa Surveyors advised on the 31st ultimo that she was still sunk and that the owner was negotiating with the British Embassy in Rome with a view to this yacht being restored to her.
