



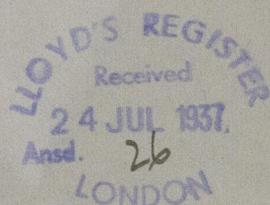


We duly received your letter of the 22nd inst. having reference to the plans of the Switchboards recently submitted by Messrs. John I. Thornycroft & Co. for their yard No. 1172 and in reply have to inform you that the 2 KW generator is connected to the board through a circuit breaker and reverse trip gear.

The generator is intended to supply lighting current when the vessel is cruising, and cannot be run in parallel with the main generator.

The DP circuit breaker will not be mounted on the board, but adjacent to it.

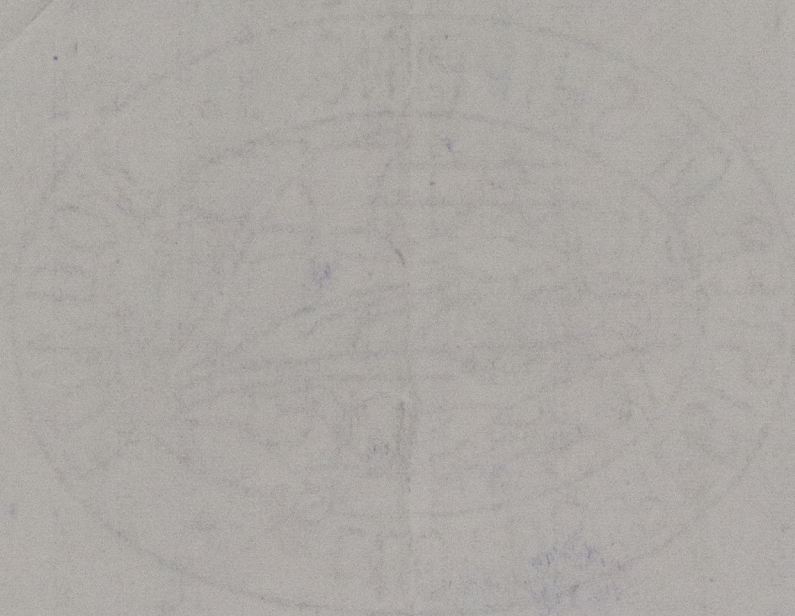
