I duly received your letter of the 9th instant, with enclosures, relating to the above vessel, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that the plans of Piping Arrangement of Water, Compressed Air, Fuel and Lubricating Oil, and Exhaust Systems will be approved, provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1936-7) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

It is concluded that one of the lubricating Oil pumps on each engine is capable of performing the entire lubricating oil service for that engine in the event of the other pump breaking down.

I have to add that you should satisfy yourselves regarding the oil fuel drainage arrangements in way of the heating boiler. Two sets of the plans are being returned under separate cover.
