In March last, in reply to enquiry, the Owners wrote that the vessel was laid up off the Island of Skiathos, which is some distance from Piraeus, the nearest mainland port and difficult to reach as there are no regular communications; also, should the Surveyor be delayed in carrying out the inspection he would find no conveniences there. The Owners further stated that the vessel had been laid up some time and when she was eventually commissioned her first port of call would be Piraeus and they would then make arrangements with the local Surveyors to carry out the survey, and the Committee
