Survey Due Boiler Survey became due 7,38.

Notices in regard to this inspection were addressed to the Owners on the 7th November and 13th December last, but failed to elicit a reply.

On the 27th ultimo a letter was forwarded to the Owners calling attention to the inspection in question, and in reply they write that the vessel is at present laid up with only a watchman on board off the Island of Skiathos, which is some distance from Piraeus, the nearest mainland port, and difficult to reach, there being no regular communication; also, should a Surveyor be sent there he would find no conveniences if he were delayed.

The Owners add that the vessel has now been laid up for a considerable time, but when she is eventually recommissioned her first port of call will be Piraeus and arrangements will then be made with the local Surveyors to carry out the survey of the boilers.
